MODIFICATION NO.1 TO THE ELECTRICITY AND WATER (LICENCE EXEMPTION) ORDER NO.1 OF 1999

The Regulation and Supervision Bureau for the Water and Electricity Sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi in accordance with Article 4 of the Electricity and Water (Licence

Whereas, the Bureau, in exercise of its powers conferred under Article (79) of Law No (2) of 1998 Concerning the Regulation of the Water and Electricity Sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi (the exempt certain persons including the

the periods specified therein;

Whereas, the exemption to ADNOC and its Affiliates for the desalination of water, the generation of electricity and the combined generation of electricity and desalination of water has lapsed;

Whereas, the Order is subject to modification or revocation by the Bureau at any time and from time to time;

Whereas, the Abu Dhabi Oil Refin to interconnect its generation facility in Ruwais to the transmission system of the Abu Dhabi Transmission and Despatch Company, the licensed transmission operator, to sell electricity to the Abu Dhabi Water and Electricity Company and purchase electricity from the Abu Dhabi Distribution Company;

Whereas, the Bureau has a general duty under Article (54) to ensure the operation and development of a safe, efficient and economic water and electricity sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi;

Whereas, the Bureau intends to issue a separate order under Articles (79) and (80) of the Law granting an exemption to TAKREER for generation of electricity in Ruwais with certain conditions attached thereto; and

Now, therefore, the Bureau makes this Modification as follows:

ARTICLE (1) Citation and Commencement

This Modification shall be referred to as the Modification No.1 to the Electricity and Water (Licence Exemption) Order No.1 of 1999 and shall come into effect on 17 June 2001.

ARTICLE (2) Definitions



The words and expressions used but not defined in this Modification shall have the meanings ascribed to them in paragraph 1 or paragraph 2 of the Order, as the case may be.

ARTICLE (3) Modification to Order No.1 of 1999

Pursuant to Article 4 of the Order, the Bureau hereby modifies the Order as follows:

1. The following new definition is hereby added in paragraph 1 of Article 2 of the Order:

ADNOC

2. Paragraph 2 of Article 3 of the Order is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following new paragraph 2 of Article 3:

Affiliates and Main Condition for ADNOC

2. The exemptions conferred by paragraph 1 of this Order on those persons referred to in paragraphs 3(a) shall apply to the persons specified and each of their Affiliates. However, the exemption to ADNOC in respect of generation of electricity referred to in paragraph 3(a) shall lapse for the generation of electricity in Ruwais by the Abu Dhabi Oil separate exemption is issued to TAKREER for generation in Ruwais. Provided, further, that ADNOC shall not connect in any manner and for any purpose with the transmission systems of the licensed transmission operator any and all of its facilities capable of the generation of electricity, desalination of water or both, or the transmission, distribution or supply of water or electricity.
3. Sub-paragraphs 4(b) and 4(c) and the first sub-paragraph 4(d) of Article 3 of the Order are hereby renumbered to 4(b)(i), 4(b)(ii) and 4(c), respectively, without affecting the references to such sub-paragraphs made anywhere in the Order.
4. Sub-paragraph 5(a)(i) of Article 3 of the Order is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following new sub-paragraph:
 - (i) paragraph (i), for 12 months from the Transfer Date, or until revoked by
